

## **Recyclable**

**Metal:** Cans and empty aerosol cans

**Aluminum:** Cans, foil, pie pans

**Plastics:** All rigid containers with hash 1-7 on bottom and black nursery pots

**Glass:** Green, clear and brown bottles and jars

**Paper:** Catalogs, newspapers, magazines, corrugated cardboard (including empty pizza boxes), fiberboard, cereal and cracker boxes, beverage carrying containers, shoe and gift boxes, paper grocery and shopping bags, telephone books, computer and office paper, junk mail; large cardboard boxes (need to be broken down and flattened to 4 by 6).

## **Not Recyclable**

**Aluminum:** Lawn furniture, cooking utensils, door screens, pots and pans

**Metal:** Knives, forks, spoons, license plates, car parts, clothes hangers, tools

**Glass:** Dishes, mirrors, windows, drinking glasses, medicine bottles, cookware (Pyrex, Corning etc), light bulbs

**Plastics:** Auto fluid containers, pool chemical bottles, plastic grocery bags and newspaper sleeves, polystyrene trays, Styro-foam, egg cartons, clothes hangers and all flower pots except the black variety.

**Paper:** Shredded paper, juice boxes and milk cartons (containers with waxed layer), air filters.
